Cooperative Extension faculty/staff reach the public through direct teaching, publications, exhibits, mass and social media, satellite videoconferences, phone contacts, letters, and World Wide Web and computer/phone networks. Cooperative Extension contacts are for calendar year 2011, *except* for the Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey contacts which are reported for fiscal years.
